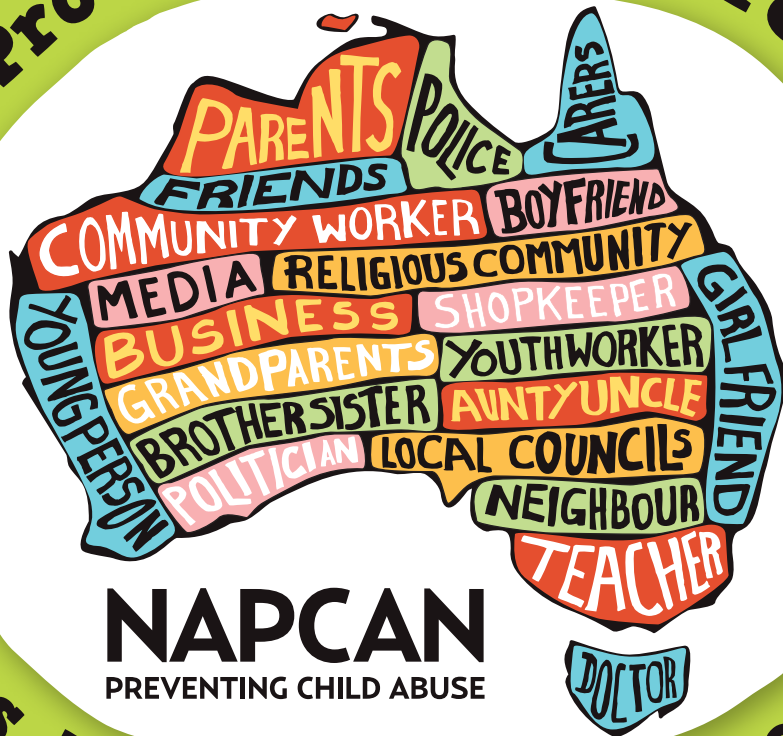

## Suggested activity - 'What makes me feel safe in my community'.

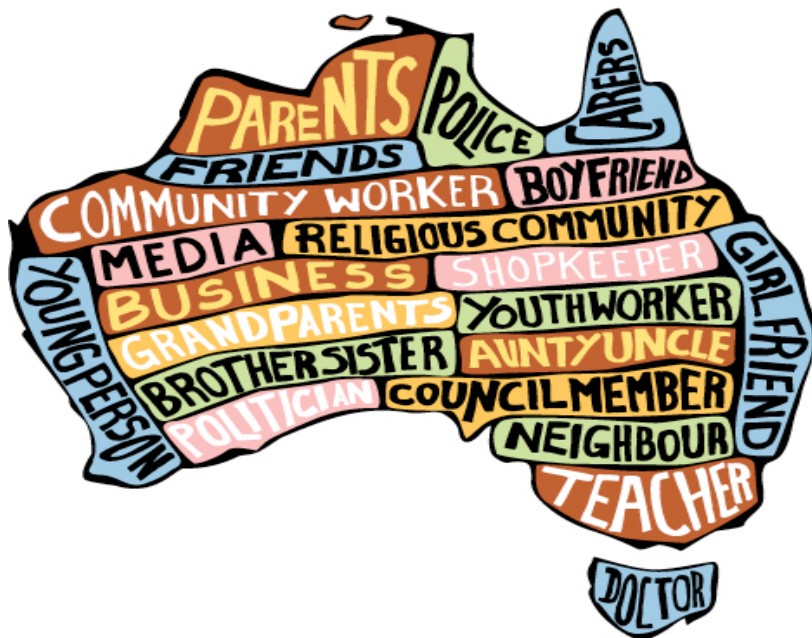
National Child Protection Week (held from the first Sunday in September) provides an opportunity each year for early childhood educators to talk to children about safe and unsafe feelings, people and places in their community.

Use the circular card included to create an activity related to your discussions. This activity provides a fun outcome, as it's an opportunity for children to express through creative art what makes them feel safe in their community.

Children are encouraged to draw, paint or use craft material to depict the things, or people or places that make them feel safe.

Early childhood communities are then encouraged to showcase children's work through the creation of mobiles, decorations or other inventive ways and invite family and friends to view them.

NAPCAN also wants to take this activity further by inviting early childhood communities to register their activity with the QLD Office. By actively participating in this activity, having children's artwork on display and registering with NAPCAN early childhood communities will go into a draw to win a fabulous prize for their Centre!
